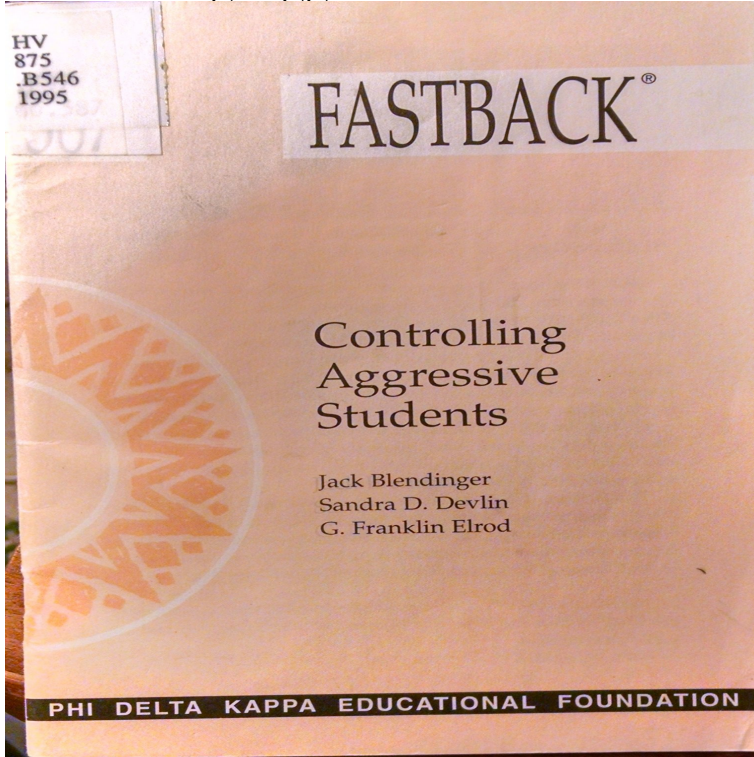


Controlling Aggressive Students

Be assertive when breaking up fights. Respond calmly but firmly to an aggressive student. Consider giving the student a time out. After the aggressive student cools down, talk with him privately. Have the student apologize. Have students who were involved in a conflict fill out a. Remain calm. Shouting or being aggressive yourself toward an aggressive student is never, ever a good idea. Remember, you are trying to diffuse the situation, not make it worse! If you take a calming approach, then you increase the chances of the student calming down.
